ABOUT THE MUSICAL

Set during the French Revolution, THE TALE: A New Musical is an epic story of love, sacrifice, and redemption across two cities divided by fear and unrest. As revolution erupts in Paris and tensions rise in England, one man must decide whether to give up everything for the people he loves.

Inspired by Charles Dickens' A Tale of Two Cities, THE TALE explores the human cost of revolution and the hope that can endure in dark times. Through powerful music and emotional storytelling, the musical reimagines this classic tale with urgency, compassion, and heart.

THE INTENSIVE EXPERIENCE

This is not a traditional fully staged production.

The New Works Theatre Intensive is a collaborative workshop process focused on:

- Script development
- Character exploration
- Musical collaboration
- Staging experimentation
- Projection and design integration
- Audience engagement
- New work discovery

Participants will work directly with the creative team throughout the rehearsal process and gain valuable insight into the creation and refinement of a brand-new musical.

The week will culminate in two public staged readings for audiences.

REHEARSAL & PERFORMANCE EXPECTATIONS

Rehearsal will run from 6:00pm-10:00pm. Because this is an intensive workshop process, rehearsal attendance is extremely important.

Participants should expect:

- Collaborative rehearsal work
- Script adjustments throughout the process
- Music rehearsals
- Staging exploration
- Fast-paced creative development
- Flexibility and ensemble-focused storytelling

Actors cast in the production are expected to prioritize attendance throughout the workshop week.

CAST OF CHARACTERS

PRINCIPAL MALE ROLES

Sydney Carton: A hard-drinking, womanizing lawyer who loves Lucie Manette; his final act redeems his wasted life.

Charles Darnay: Carton's lookalike, he is a good man who rejects his French father's evil lifestyle and moves to England; he marries Lucie Manette.

Doctor Manette: Wrongly imprisoned in the Bastille for 18 years, the doctor finally meets his daughter and restarts his life.

Jarvis Lorry: A good friend to Doctor Manette who deeply cares for Lucie and the doctor.

Ernest Defarge: Doctor Manette's former servant who now owns a wine shop in Paris.

SECONDARY MALE ROLES

C.J. Stryver: A pompous lawyer and Carton's boss.

Jerry Cruncher: Mr. Lorry's hired man who sells corpses to doctors.

Marquis St. Evremonde: A wealthy aristocrat whose evil deeds are legendary.

Jacques #1: French revolutionary.

Jacques #2: French revolutionary.

Jacques #3: French revolutionary.

John Barsad: A British criminal who eventually helps Carton save Darnay.

Lucie Manette: A compassionate young woman reunited with her father.

Madame Defarge: Consumed by revenge and rage.

Miss Pross: Lucie's fiercely protective nurse.

The Vengeance: Madame Defarge's revolutionary ally.

The Furies: A revolutionary ally to Madame Defarge.
